Who We Are

St. Ambrose University, founded in 1882, is a coeducational, liberal arts university rated among the top in the region by two national ranking publications. Maintaining an 11-to-1 student-to-faculty ratio, the university offers more than 75 areas of study leading to bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees.

International applicants can receive an admissions decision within two weeks of applying any time of the year. Qualified first-year applicants are eligible for scholarships of up to 50% of one year's tuition. The Office of International Student Services provides support for currently enrolled international students.

More than 3,100 students are enrolled at the university including approximately 2,500 undergraduate students and 800 graduate students. St. Ambrose University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission and a member of the North Central Association. It is affiliated with the Diocese of Davenport and easily accessed by Chicago airports.

Scholarships

Admissions Requirements

- > **Apply online at apply.sau.edu**
- > Email your **official transcripts** (e.g. predicted grades, mark sheet, internal marks or academic record) via your counselor or registrar's office.
- > Email scanned copy of your **passport** photo page
- > Email the completed **Declaration of Finances** Form along with proof of funding (\$45,000).
- > Send **only one of the following exam scores** as proof of English proficiency, or enroll in our ESL program.
- > **For Undergraduate Admissions**
 - TOEFL iBT minimum of **79** (avg. 98)
 - TOEFL PBT minimum of **550**
 - IELTS minimum of **6.0** (avg. 6.2)
 - PTE minimum of **53**
 - ACT minimum composite score of **18** (avg. 23)
 - SAT minimum combined score of **860** (avg. 1080), *math and critical reading only*
 - ELS completion of level **112**
 - IB Higher Level English minimum of **5**
- > **For Graduate Admissions***
 - TOEFL iBT minimum of **85**
 - TOEFL PBT minimum of **563**
 - IELTS minimum of **6.5**
 - PTE minimum of **58**

- > For students with no exam score or scores below the requirement, St. Ambrose offers an intensive English language program on campus provided by INTERLINK. Completion of the program will fulfill the English proficiency requirement for undergraduate admission and certain graduate programs. Conditional admission to SAU will be offered to INTERLINK students seeking a degree if their academic transcripts are approved by the Admissions Office. Students will receive full admission upon completion of the program.
